COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

S3DA has partnered with USA Archery to ensure students can continue to compete at the college level. Eligible students enrolled at a college or university which has a USA Archery Collegiate Program can work to develop fundamental skills, compete for individual, regional and national team championships and also earn Academic and All-American awards. This partnership encourages colleges across the nation to recruit potential S3DA archers and also consider them for scholarship opportunities.
